2010-2011 School Year Enrollment Commitment

Between Wednesday, December 2nd and Thursday, January 7th, our existing families will have first priority to make an enrollment commitment to attend SnoSprings next Fall. Beginning Jan. 8th, any remaining seats will be allocated to new families outside of the school. Of particular interest to our current kindergarten and first grade families is a recent decision to offer a combined first and second grade class next year. This decision was based on input and special requests for second grade by many of our existing parents. There is space for 18 students in the 1st/2nd grade classroom and seats will be allocated on a first come basis. The ratio of 1st vs. 2nd graders will depend on what families make enrollment commitments during the next five weeks. Also new next year will be the addition of all day Pre-K and elimination of our half day option. This decision was also based on input received by prospective Pre-K families. Please register early to guarantee your child's seat availability. Pre-registration information will be sent home on Wednesday, December 2nd.

Tuition Payment Due December 1st

As a reminder for those families paying monthly, the Pre-K tuition payment is \$530 and the K-1 tuition payment is \$890. For those families paying quarterly, your second payment is not due until January 1st. Pre-K payment is \$1,575 and K-1 is \$2,655.

Winter Vacation Begins Saturday Dec. 19th

Just a reminder that our last day of school for 2009 will be Friday, December 18th. SnoSprings will open again Monday, Jan. 4th 2010. Wishing you all a safe and happy holiday season.
