Title and Duties

Physical Education Specialist - Teach five, half-hour class sessions, twice weekly. There are 18 students in each class with the assistance of an Ed. Assistant. Students are in Pre-K, Kindergarten, 1st / 2nd grades.

- Collaborate with the teaching team to plan health and fitness themes/programs.
- After school sports club from 3-4PM also an option with additional pay \$75/hour.
