Title and Duties

Music Specialist, Part-time, 12:15–2:45PM, Two days a week T/TH

- Teach five, 30-minute classes of 18 K-Prep through 2nd grade students.
- Use the Washington State K–12 Arts Learning Standards for Music and other resource guides to develop 10-month curriculum and weekly lesson plans.
- Teach K-2 students basic note reading and instrument playing through recorders or glockenspiels
- Collaborate with the teaching team to plan themes, projects, programs, or other musical activities.
- Coordinate two musical productions for the full school enrollment to highlight musical progress and achievements (one in the winter and one in the spring)
- Maintain professional appearance & communications.
- Provide regular communications to parents through monthly newsletter.
- Assess student performance for quarterly progress reports and as necessary, when requested from teaching staff or parents.

Qualifications

The highly energetic candidate should have the following qualifications:

- ✓ Washington State teaching certificate appropriate to grade level and/or Successful elementary or ECE level training/teaching/Rec. Ctr. experience, and/or Commitment to continued learning and professional growth.
- ✓ Experience working in Early Childhood or Elementary Education a plus.
- ✓ First Aid/CPR certificate and flawless background working with children.
- ✓ Provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination prior to Aug. 29, 2022 and follow COVID protocols.
