Responsibilities

Physical Education Specialist - Teach five, half-hour class sessions, twice weekly 12:15 – 2:45pm. There are 18 students in each class with the assistance of an Ed. Assistant. Students are in K-Prep, Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grades.
